BELOW THE ALICE THRESHOLD

This data highlights children who are below the ALICE Threshold and living in families that are either in poverty or are **ALICE®** (Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed). Typically undercounted and overlooked, ALICE lives paycheck to paycheck – earning above the poverty level, but less than the cost of household basics.
